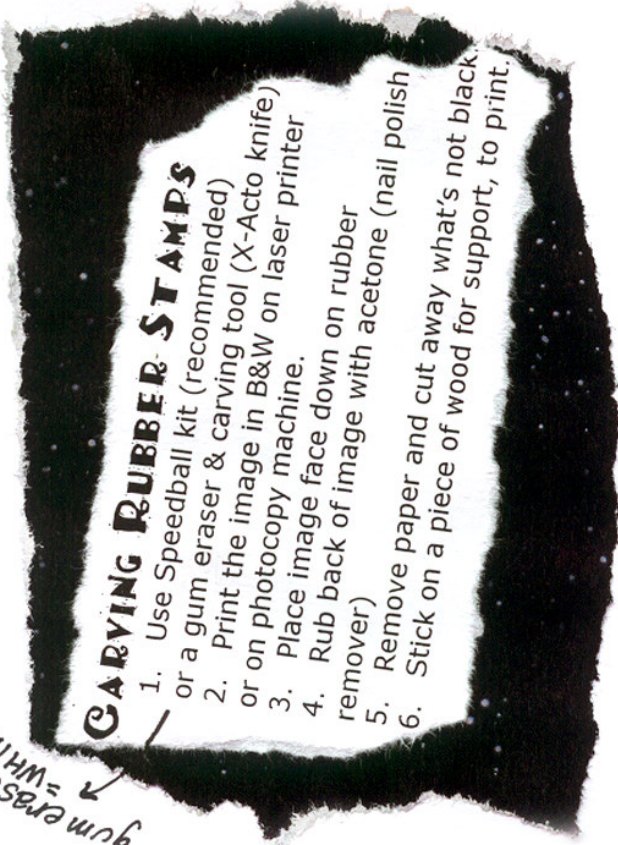

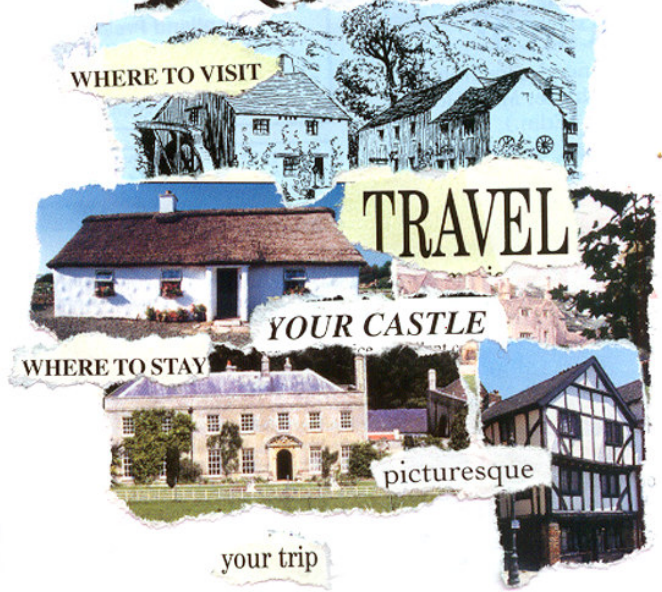


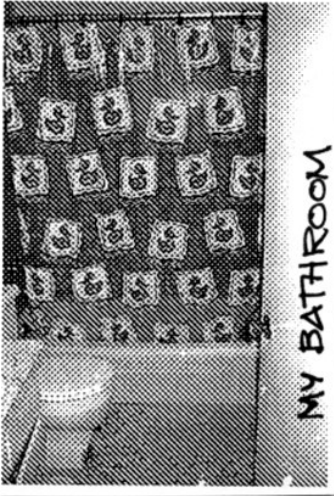
**CARVING RUBBER STAMPS**

1. Use Speedball kit (recommended) or a gum eraser & carving tool (X-Acto knife) or on photocopy machine.
2. Print the image in B&W on laser printer
3. Place image face down.
4. Rub back of image with rubber remover)
5. Remove paper and cut away what's not black.
6. Stick on a piece of wood for support, to print.

gum eraser = white

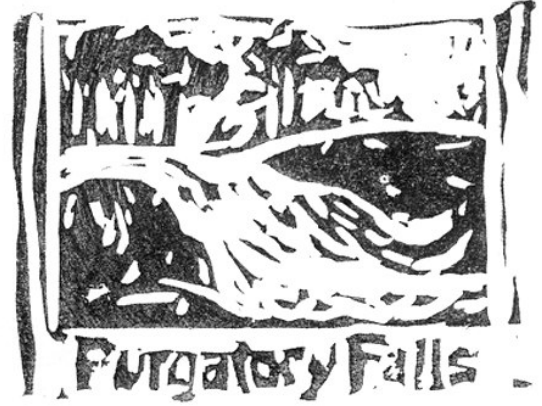
